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# A BRIEF PROFILE OF FATIMA HOSPITAL

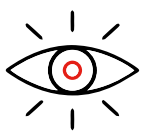


Fatima Hospital is a 200 bedded non-profitable/charitable NABH and NABL accredited hospital run by the Catholic Diocese of Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh, India. Fatima Hospital is the health unit of Purvanchal Gramin Seva Samiti (PGGS); a society registered under the Society's registration act 1860 having registration number 503. It had its humble beginning 27 years back in 1995 with 20 beds provision for general medical and OB& Gynae facilities. At present Fatima hospital has emerged as a 200 bedded referral hospital, rendering the best healthcare services to various categories of patients in the region of Eastern Uttar Pradesh. We do have a very strong community-based programme and development interventions in rural areas covering more than 1200 villages in 7 civil districts of this Eastern Uttar Pradesh (Purvanchal) which cover an approximate population of 18 million people.

Fatima hospital has established seven satellite clinics and seven vision centers in various parts of the focus area to

mobilise and enhance its community health activities. We have vital community interventions through regular conduction of camps, educative programmes, etc. We organize Medical Camps, Eye Camps, Cardiac Camps, Mother and Child Care camps, Blood Donation camps, Dental camps, free vaccination programmes, corona Services etc.

The satellite clinics network helps Fatima hospital to provide the best services to the unreachable people living in remote rural areas. The hospital has various departments like Cardiology, Cardio-Vascular Surgery (CTVS), Urology, Neurology, Gastro-enterology, Nephrology, Pulmonary Medicine, Dermatology, Medicine, General Surgery, Gynecology, Ophthalmology, Pediatrics, ENT, Ophthalmology, Dental, Radiology & Imaging, Pharmacy, Pathology, NICU, PICU, MICU, SICU, Dialysis, Physiotherapy, Community health and department of Blood Transfusion.

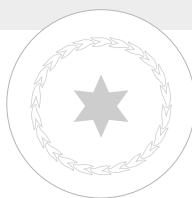

## A BRIEF HISTORY OF FIMS

**F**atima Institute of Medical Sciences (FIMS) is owned and administered by the Catholic Diocese of Gorakhpur and was started in the year 2009. The purpose of the Institute was to empower the women of eastern Uttar Pradesh (Purvanchal) through nursing and paramedical education and thus to provide qualified healthcare professionals for the health sector in India as well as to build up a skilled healthcare workforce for the society.

The Institute offers a 4-year Bachelor's degree in Nursing (B.Sc. Nursing), a 3-year diploma course in General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM), a 2-year diploma course in Auxiliary Nursing Midwifery (ANM), a 2-year diploma course in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT), and a 2 years diploma course in Optometry (DOPT) recognized by Atal Bihari Bajpayee Medical University (ABVMU), U.P. State Medical Faculty, Lucknow and the Indian Nursing Council (INC), New Delhi.

**B.Sc. Nursing** started in the year 2022. We have an intake of 40 students (Boys and Girls) for the B.Sc., course per batch per year.

**GNM Nursing** started in the year 2009 with 28 students. We have an intake of 40 students (Girls only) for GNM per year.

**ANM Nursing** began in the year 2021 with 40 students (Girls only). We have an intake of 40 students for ANM per batch per year.

**The DMLT Course** was started in the year 2007 with 9 students, affiliated with Indian Medical Association, New Delhi. Later on, DMLT Course was affiliated with both IMA & the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS). In the year 2022, the DMLT course was shifted from IMA & NIOS to affiliation under Medical Faculty, Lucknow. We have an intake of 30 students (Boys and Girls) per batch per year.

**The DOPT Course** was begun in the year 2009 affiliated with Medical Faculty Lucknow. The first batch began with 06 students. We have an intake of 30 students per batch per year.

Since the start of FIMS, several Nursing and Paramedical students have passed out of the institute with flying colours. On the roll, 459 GNM students 243 DMLT students and 137 DOPT students have passed out successfully completing the course from FIMS and are placed in various prestigious health care institutions all over Indian and abroad.

- FIMS intends to assist in the training and development of young boys and girls of this region into dedicated healthcare professionals by instilling in them values of self-discipline, commitment to their profession, respect for life, and service to humanity.
- To focus on community health needs and make necessary interventions whenever essential through timely involvement and teamwork.
- To acquire the interest and aptitude for research and modern scientific advancements in medicine.
- To obtain an exemplary steadfastness to medical ethics and moral values to witness a life of honesty and integrity.
- To train and transform students into future leaders loyal to the highest ideals of the health profession.

### OBJECTIVES

- To strive towards achieving excellence in healthcare by promoting medical, nursing, and paramedical education.
- To serve the medically under-served areas and people of our country.
- To provide value-based human formation to our students.
- To uphold respect and compassion for the patients and their families.
- We believe that well trained and committed nurses/paramedical staff with ethical practices could change the course of action in the health care services through their professional approach and timely interventions along with compassionate and quality services to the people in the community manifested in Christian love for the humanity.
- Being aware of the pressing need of the profession, we are committed to provide nursing education to students, who have the potential and motivated to become nurse-educators, nurse-researchers, skilled staff who will be able to contribute towards meeting the issues and challenges confronting the nursing and paramedical profession.



## BASIC B.Sc. (NURSING) DEGREE COURSE (B.Sc Nursing)

This programme of study leads to a Basic B.Sc. (Nursing) degree from the Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical University, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh, under its affiliation to Medical Faculty, Lucknow and Indian Nursing Council (INC), New Delhi, with an intake of 40 seats open to both boys and girls.

### Educational Objectives:

After this course, the graduates are expected: -

- To understand the broad concept of the fundamental principles of quality nursing care and demonstrate skills in providing nursing care to patients of all age groups based on physical, biological and behavioural sciences, principles in an institution or a community setting.
- To develop critical thinking skills in making decisions and demonstrate leadership qualities in various nursing situations.
- To participate effectively as members of the health care team in promotive, preventive and restorative health services in line with the National Health Policies (NHP) and programmes.
- To demonstrate skills in teaching and supervising nursing care in the hospital and the community setting.
- To execute the latest trends and technologies to provide advanced healthcare services to the sick and suffering.
- To recognise the need for continued learning and personal and professional growth.

### Duration of the Course:

- The B.Sc. Nursing is a degree course of 4 years.

### Eligibility Criteria

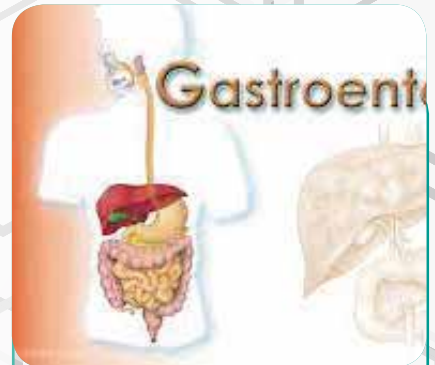

# GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

All students are expected to follow the below given rules and regulations.

1. These rules and regulations are subject to change from time to time.
2. The students are strictly under the principal, tutors, and warden's supervision and direction.
3. The students' performance is evaluated periodically, especially before promotion or appearance for Board Examinations.
4. The students must complete their academic requirements each year to become eligible for appearing in the annual examinations.
5. Students abstaining from duty without prior permission from the principal, class coordinator, warden or the department in-charges will be guilty of misconduct.
6. Holidays are scheduled per the calendar and directions of the State Medical Faculty, University and respective boards. The number of holidays may vary from course to course.
7. Hostel students can go shopping/'outing' once a month with the warden's permission or concerned in-charges.
8. Students residing in the hostel can go on vacation with their parents or legal guardian only; otherwise, parents need to give written consent stating that their daughter/son is capable of travelling alone.
9. Students staying in the hostel are allowed to meet only those relatives whose names are registered in the hostel register of guardians. Days and times for outing/visitors are as follows: -
  - Students are not allowed to meet their relatives after 4 pm.
11. Eligibility for Admission to Examination:
  - A candidate must have a minimum of 80% attendance (irrespective of the kind of absence) in theory and practical in each course/ subject for appearing for the examination.
  - A candidate must have 100% attendance in each of the practical areas before award of degree/ diploma.
  - A candidate must secure 50% marks in internal assessment separately in each theory and practical.
12. Students are not permitted to go out in the company of any staff.
13. Students are strictly forbidden to keep the radio, tape recorders, mobile phones, or other electronic devices; if they are found with any students, they will be confiscated, and disciplinary action will be taken against them.
14. Only keypad phones are allowed with the students, and the keypad phones have to be deposited with the warden. Only on weekends, students will have permission to make phone calls or in case of an emergency.
15. Students are supposed to undergo a routine medical examination every year. If a student is found medically unfit, they may be asked to discontinue. The students must meet all the medical expenses. The hospital facilities for the medical treatment will be as follows:
  - If students are admitted to the hospital, they should pay a subsidized amount for the treatment, which is as follows-  
Room charges -Semi-Pvt Ward – Rs. 700/-, Private Room (AC) – Rs.1000/-
  - Nursing Care will be free.
  - All the Lab tests and other investigations are payable.
  - Special consultation like (Ortho, Dental, Eye, X-Ray, ECG, ECO) will be chargeable.
  - Medicines are chargeable.
  - Those who are having no money with them at the time of treatment, the bill will be entered into the credit of the School of Nursing. Students need to collect the bill from the billing section and have to submit it to the school office. Students shall make the clearance of the payment in 15 days from the school office subsequently.

10. The Christian/Catholic students are encouraged to attend daily Holy Mass, Rosary and other spiritual activities.



16. Any student suffering from a severe illness requiring rest is sent home for recovery. In case of prolonged absence due to ill health and thereby failing to comply with the attendance norms of the Medical Faculty, shall be asked to repeat the year.
17. Any misconduct, disobedience, inefficiency or repeated serious negligence of duty will be dealt with seriously to the extent of dismissal.
18. Students are not permitted to keep any ornaments/ jewellery of gold or silver, and the institution will not be held responsible in case of theft or loss.
19. Students can talk to their parents over the phone only on Saturday and Sunday.
20. Annual fees need to be deposited on time. In case of late fee submission, a fine of Rs. 1500/- (Rs. 50/- per day) per month must be given along with the late fees.
21. The school/hostel authorities have the power to open letters and check their mobiles without their prior permission/consent in case of suspicion.
22. Students need to inform the hostel warden before consulting a doctor. No student can seek medical advice without giving the warden/principal prior knowledge. Students need to submit medical certificates of their treatment; otherwise, they will be marked absent.
23. Students are strictly forbidden to accept gifts or hospitality from patients or their attendees.
24. Students will be asked to replace or compensate for loss or damage caused to equipment or hospital/school property.
25. Students in the hostel should maintain silence during study hours and are expected to self-study from 8.00 pm to 10.30 pm.
26. Except for those on night duty, all students are requested to keep the meal timings.
27. All students are expected to dine in the mess hall. Taking food to the dormitories is strictly forbidden.
28. The students will not leave the hostel premises without the permission of the hostel warden.
29. The students are expected to sleep in their own rooms/ dormitories; any change of rooms shall be with the prior permission of the warden only.
30. Students are not permitted to keep religious statues or posters in their rooms/dormitories.
31. Students have to keep their uniforms neat, clean, and well-maintained. During the winter season, students must wear a high-neck black sweater.
32. Students have to follow the proper dress code during duty hours and should carry identity cards all the time.
33. Students are not allowed to meet visitors during duty or class hours. Disciplinary actions will be taken against the students.
34. Students will not be allowed to sit in exams if they have not finished their case study records, procedure books, care plans and other records in the stipulated time.
35. Periodical parent-teacher meetings will be held in which students' overall and academic progress will be discussed. The forum and time will be shared via phone one week before the meeting. Parents are requested to attend the meeting, and no excuse will be accepted for not attending.
36. There will not be a refund of fees if students decide to leave the course without completion. Also, it is mandatory to submit the fine for the same.
37. Students are not allowed to pursue any other course during these courses.
38. Students are responsible for the safety of their belongings. In case of theft or damage to any belongings of other students, strict disciplinary actions will be taken against the guilty students.
39. It is mandatory for the parents to inform the school management in writing about any psychological disorders their child may be suffering from or if their child is taking any medication which may alter the mental status of the student. If students harm themselves because of the disease/medication, the institution will not bear any responsibility.
